## **Bill Summary**

The bill requires the small business assistance center under the office of economic development to create a small business navigator to provide a single point of contact for small businesses in order to facilitate and assist small businesses by:

- ! Making referrals to small business development centers, the business advancement center operated by the university of Colorado, or other such centers or organizations;
- ! Providing information regarding state government contracting offices and processes;
- ! Providing assistance with state rules; and

! Conducting any follow-up with the small business as needed.

The bill also requires the office of economic development to advise and provide guidance to the small business navigator.

2 **SECTION 1. Legislative declaration.** The general assembly 3 hereby finds and declares that the Colorado office of economic 4 development shall complete only those tasks specified in House Bill 5 11-1209, enacted in 2011, that the office can currently do at no cost and 6 shall then transition to other tasks as resources become available and as 7 such tasks become cost effective. 8 **SECTION 2.** 24-48.5-101 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read: 10 24-48.5-101. Colorado office of economic development -11 **creation.** (3) The Colorado office of economic development shall advise 12 and provide guidance to THE SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR DESCRIBED IN 13 SECTION 24-48.5-102 AND SHALL ADVISE AND PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO 14 coordinate activities of small business development centers and the 15 business advancement center operated by the university of Colorado. 16 **SECTION 3.** 24-48.5-102 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 17 amended to read: 18 24-48.5-102.
