A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR BY THE

Bill Summary

The bill requires the small business assistance center under the office of economic development to create a small business navigator to provide a single point of contact for small businesses in order to facilitate and assist small businesses by:

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- ! Diagnosing problems;
- ! Making referrals to small business development centers, the business advancement center operated by the university of Colorado, or other such centers or organizations;
- Providing information regarding state government contracting offices and processes;
- ! Providing assistance with state rules; and
- ! Conducting any follow-up with the small business as needed.

The bill also requires the office of economic development to advise and provide guidance to the small business navigator.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. The general assembly hereby finds and declares that the Colorado office of economic development shall complete only those tasks specified in House Bill 11-1209, enacted in 2011, that the office can currently do at no cost and shall then transition to other tasks as resources become available and as such tasks become cost effective.

8 **SECTION 2.** 24-48.5-101 (3), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read:

24-48.5-101. Colorado office of economic development creation. (3) The Colorado office of economic development shall advise
 and provide guidance to THE SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR DESCRIBED IN
 SECTION 24-48.5-102 AND SHALL ADVISE AND PROVIDE GUIDANCE TO
 coordinate activities of small business development centers and the
 business advancement center operated by the university of Colorado.

SECTION 3. 24-48.5-102 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is

1 Colorado office of economic development shall include the small 2 business assistance center, which shall provide comprehensive 3 information on the federal, state, and local requirements necessary to 4 begin a business and shall make this information available to the public. 5 (b) ____ THE SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE CENTER SHALL ALSO 6 CREATE A SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR THAT SHALL PROVIDE A SINGLE 7 POINT OF CONTACT FOR SMALL BUSINESSES IN ORDER TO FACILITATE AND 8 ASSIST SMALL BUSINESSES BY: 9 (I) DIAGNOSING PROBLEMS; 10 (II) PROVIDING INFORMATION AND STREAMLINING REFERRALS TO 11 SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTERS, THE COLORADO CREDIT 12 RESERVE PROGRAM, THE FEDERAL SMALL BUSINESS CREDIT INITIATIVE, OR 13 OTHER SUCH CENTERS OR ORGANIZATIONS; 14 (III) PROVIDING INFORMATION REGARDING STATE GOVERNMENT 15 CONTRACTING OFFICES AND PROCESSES; 16 (IV) PROVIDING ASSISTANCE WITH STATE RULES; AND 17 (V) CONDUCTING ANY FOLLOW-UP WITH THE SMALL BUSINESS AS 18 NEEDED. 19 (II) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 15, 2012, AND ON OR BEFORE EACH 20 JANUARY 15 THEREAFTER, THE COLORADO OFFICE OF ECONOMIC 21 DEVELOPMENT SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE BUSINESS, LABOR, AND 22 TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE ECONOMIC AND 23 BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, 24 OR SUCH SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, WHICH REPORT SHALL INCLUDE, BUT 25 NEED NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE NUMBER OF SMALL BUSINESSES BEING 26 SERVED BY THE SMALL BUSINESS NAVIGATOR.
