Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$47,198 cash funds from the Employment Support Fund to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2012-13. Staff has prepared amendment **J.005** (attached) to change the existing clause to appropriate \$47,198 from gifts, grants, and donations received by the Division of Employment and Training and to reappropriate \$14,948 of this sum to the Office of Information Technology for the provision of computer center services related to the implementation of this act. Amendment **J.005** does not change the total appropriation of \$47,198 cash funds for FY 2012-13.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

A specific source of gifts, grants, and donations for the administrative costs of implementation of this act has not been identified.
