**TITLE:** CONCERNING THE USE OF A VIDEO DISPLAY IN A MOTOR VEHICLE THAT IS BEING OPERATED ON A ROADWAY.**Summary of Legislation**

This bill allows video displays in any location of a moving motor vehicle, so long as the display is not visible to the driver. This bill does not apply to video screens used for safety purposes. Under current law, video screens are prohibited at any point forward of the back of the drivers' seat.

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 13, 2012 and took effect July 1, 2012.

**State Revenue and Expenditures**

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. There are only about 12 cases with a conviction to this charge per fiscal year. While the bill allows certain behavior that was previously prohibited, it also broadens the content that may not be viewable. These changes together will cancel one another out.
