TITLE: CONCERNING REQUIRING LOCAL BUILDING CODES TO ALLOW THE USE OF LUMBER MILLED FROM CERTAIN TREES AS BUILDING FRAMING MATERIAL.**Summary of Legislation**

This bill requires county and municipal building codes to allow and encourage the use of lumber milled from lodgepole pine or Engelmann spruce trees having a grade of "stud" or better for the framing of buildings. The bill is effective upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature. The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House Agriculture, Livestock and Natural Resources Committee on April 18, 2012.

Assessment

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. It does not require any increase in workload or expenditures by any state agency. The bill does require local governments to modify their building codes, but the fiscal note assumes this can be accomplished in the normal course of building code revisions.
