Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB12-1238 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend the State, Veterans & Military Affairs Committee Report, dated
2 April 25, 2012, page 25, line 13, strike "22-7-1210." and substitute
3 "22-7-1210; EXCEPT THAT THE AMOUNT CREDITED TO THE EARLY
4 LITERACY FUND PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH (c) SHALL NOT EXCEED
5 SIXTEEN MILLION DOLLARS IN ANY STATE FISCAL YEAR."

6 Page 25 of the report, after line 31, insert:

7 "Page 47 of the bill, after line 13, insert:

8 "SECTION 23. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-54-104.2, **add**
9 (3) as follows:

10 **22-54-104.2. Legislative declaration.** (3) THE GENERAL
11 ASSEMBLY FURTHER FINDS AND DECLARES THAT, FOR PURPOSES OF
12 SECTION 17 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION, THE
13 REQUIREMENT THAT SCHOOL DISTRICTS PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES
14 TO JUVENILES PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-32-141 AND THAT THE SCHOOL
15 DISTRICTS RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT FOR PROVIDING THE SERVICES
16 PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-54-114 (4) (b), IS PART OF PROVIDING
17 ACCOUNTABLE PROGRAMS TO MEET STATE ACADEMIC STANDARDS AND
18 MAY THEREFORE RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THE STATE EDUCATION FUND
19 CREATED IN SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION."

20 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly."

1 Page 25 of the report, strike lines 32 through 34 and substitute:

2 "Page 47 of the bill, strike lines 14 through 27 and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 24. Appropriation.** (1) In addition to any other
4 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the early
5 literacy fund created in section 22-7-1210, Colorado Revised Statutes, not
6 otherwise appropriated, to the department of education, for the fiscal year
7 beginning July 1, 2012, the sum of \$5,411,989 and 9.8 FTE, or so much
8 thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the assistance to public
9 schools division, reading and literacy programs, for the implementation
10 of section 22-7-1210 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes.

11 (2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
12 appropriated, out of any moneys in the state education fund created in
13 section 17 (4) (a) of article IX of the state constitution, not otherwise
14 appropriated, to the department of education, for the fiscal year beginning
15 July 1, 2012, the sum of \$20,418 and 0.2 FTE, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, for allocation to the public school finance division for
17 administrative expenses related to district per pupil reimbursements for
18 juveniles held in jail.

19 (3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby
20 appropriated, out of any moneys in the state education fund created in
21 section 17 (4) (a) of article IX of the state constitution, not otherwise
22 appropriated, to the department of education, for the fiscal year beginning
23 July 1, 2012, the sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be
24 necessary, for allocation to the public school finance division for district
25 per pupil reimbursements for juveniles held in jail.

26 **SECTION 25. Appropriation - adjustments in 2012 long bill.**

27 (1) For the implementation of this act, appropriations made in the annual
28 general appropriation act to the department of education for the fiscal
29 year beginning July 1, 2012, are adjusted as follows:

30 (a) The cash funds appropriation for public school finance
31 administration is decreased by \$20,418 and 0.2 FTE. Said sum is from the
32 read-to-achieve cash fund created in section 22-7-908 (1), Colorado
33 Revised Statutes.

34 (b) The cash funds appropriation for district per pupil
35 reimbursements for juveniles held in jail is decreased by \$100,000. Said
36 sum is from the read-to-achieve cash fund created in section 22-7-908 (1),
37 Colorado Revised Statutes."
