Summary of Legislation

This bill appropriates funds from the Colorado Water Conservation Board (CWCB) Construction Fund for specific water-related projects in FY 2012-13. The bill also:

- transfers funding from the Perpetual Base Account of the Severance Tax Trust Fund to the CWCB Construction Fund to fund two projects;
- clarifies that the State Engineer is authorized to receive and expend contributions from the CWCB;
- changes the Water Supply Reserve Account to the Water Supply Reserve Fund; and
- requires the Interbasin Compact Committee to submit an annual report to the House Committee on Agriculture, Livestock, and Natural Resources, and the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Energy on the status of interbasin compact negotiations and how moneys from the Water Supply Reserve Fund were allocated.

Background

The CWCB Construction Fund was created in 1971 to provide low-interest loans for water projects. Revenues for this revolving loan fund come from interest earned on outstanding loans and the fund's cash balance and royalty distributions from federal mineral leases.

State Transfers

In FY 2012-13, the bill transfers from the Perpetual Base Account of the Severance Tax Trust Fund to the CWCB Construction Fund:

- \$30,000,000 for the Rio Grande cooperative project, including improvements associated with the Beaver Park Reservoir and the Rio Grande Reservoir; and
- \$13,000,000 for the implementation of the Chatfield Reservoir reallocation project.

State Expenditures

This bill spends \$27,575,000 in FY 2012-13 from the CWCB Construction Fund. The projects for which moneys are appropriated are shown in Table 1.

Satellite Monitoring System Maintenance – for Division of Water Resources activities related to installing, maintaining, and operating satellite monitored stream gauges for water rights administration.	\$300,000	
Weather Modification Program – provides assistance to water conservation and conservancy districts with the development of cloud seeding programs to provide benefits to recreation, streams, and reservoirs through snowpack enhancement.	175,000	
Flood Plain Map Modernization Program – provides assistance to communities to revise and improve flood plain studies and maps.	500,000	
Watershed Restoration Program – provides planning and engineering studies, including implementation measures, to address technical needs for watershed restoration and flood mitigation projects throughout the state.	500,000

Rio Grande Cooperative Project – to participate in the planning, design, and rehabilitation of the Rio Grande Reservoir.	5,000,000	
Chatfield Reservoir Reallocation Project – to participate in the implementation of the Chatfield Reservoir reallocation project.	5,000,000
