Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$525,788 cash funds from the Department of State Cash Fund in FY 2012-13 for the Department of State to begin making the enhancements to the Department's computer systems.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

Points to Consider

- 1. As noted in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note, the Department will require an additional \$1,473,470 cash funds in FY 2013-14 and FY 2014-15 to implement this bill.
- 2. The FY 2012-13 Long Bill has been introduced in the House. Based on existing appropriations and existing law, the Department of State Cash Fund has a projected fund balance at the beginning of FY 2012-13 of \$5.2 million. This bill and several other bills pending in the General Assembly potentially increase appropriations by \$2.0 million and increase revenues by \$0.7 million. The combined effect would reduce the reserve to \$3.5 million by the end of FY 2012-13, which is about \$475,000 above the required statutory reserve for the Fund.
