Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides an appropriation of \$776,460 cash funds from the Department of State Cash Fund for the Department of State in FY 2011-12 for the purchase and implementation of the election night reporting system. The clause provides spending authority for the Department until July 1, 2013.

Bill Sponsor Amendments

Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered.

Points to Consider

The FY 2012-13 Long Bill has been introduced in the House. Based on existing appropriations and existing law, the Department of State Cash Fund has a projected fund balance at the beginning of FY 2012-13 of \$5.2 million. This bill and several other bills pending in the General Assembly potentially increase appropriations by \$2.0 million and increase revenues by \$0.7 million. The combined effect would reduce the reserve to \$3.5 million by the end of FY 2012-13, which is about \$475,000 above the required statutory reserve for the Fund.

The table on the following page details the anticipated revenues and potential appropriations, including appropriations required for this bill, from the Department of State Cash Fund for FY 2011-12 and FY 2012-13.
