CONTRIBUTION DESIGNATION LINE BENEFITING THE MAKE-A-WISH FOUNDATION OF COLORADO FUND APPEARS ON STATE INDIVIDUAL INCOME

TAX RETURN FORMS.

Summary of Legislation

This bill extends the voluntary contribution designation (or income tax checkoff) benefitting the Make-A-Wish Foundation of Colorado Fund from tax year 2012 through tax year 2016. Money in the fund is used to grant the wishes of children who have been diagnosed with a life-threatening medical condition.

This bill takes effect upon the signature of the Governor or becoming law without his signature.

Background

The income tax checkoff for the Make-A-Wish Foundation of Colorado Fund first appeared on the 2009 state income tax form. For the most recent two-year period that the income tax checkoff appeared on the form, total donations were \$206,947 and the average donation was \$9.79. Table 1 provides a two-year history of money donated to the fund.
