# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING CHANGES TO THE GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, ESTABLISHING THE GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE FOR COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY - GLOBAL CAMPUS.

## **Bill Summary**

The bill establishes the governance structure for Colorado state

HOUSE 3rd Reading Unam ended March 5,2012

HOUSE 2nd Reading Unam ended March 2, 2012 university - global campus (CSU global campus), which will be a baccalaureate and graduate on-line university. CSU global campus will be governed by the CSU system board of governors, which is expanded by two advisory members to include one CSU global campus student and one CSU global campus professor.

The bill makes several clarifying and conforming changes to the board of governors statutes.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** article 31.3 to 3 title 23 as follows: 4 **ARTICLE 31.3** 5 Colorado State University - Global Campus 6 23-31.3-101. University established - role and mission. THERE 7 IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED AN ON-LINE UNIVERSITY TO BE KNOWN AS 8 COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY - GLOBAL CAMPUS, REFERRED TO IN THIS 9 ARTICLE AS "CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS". CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS IS A 10 BACCALAUREATE AND GRADUATE ON-LINE UNIVERSITY WITH THE MISSION 11 IN COLORADO OF OFFERING \_\_\_ BACCALAUREATE DEGREE COMPLETION 12 PROGRAMS FOR NONTRADITIONAL STUDENTS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE 13 COLORADO COMMUNITY COLLEGE SYSTEM AND SELECTED MASTER-LEVEL 14 GRADUATE PROGRAMS. CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL 15 APPLICABLE STATUTES AND RULES. 16 23-31.3-102. **Board of governors of the Colorado state** 17 university system to supervise. The BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE 18 COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM HAS THE GENERAL SUPERVISION OF 19 CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS AND THE CONTROL AND DIRECTION OF THE FUNDS 20 AND APPROPRIATIONS MADE THERETO. THE BOARD HAS THE POWER TO 21 RECEIVE, DEMAND, AND HOLD FOR THE USES AND PURPOSES OF CSU 22 GLOBAL CAMPUS ALL MONEY, LANDS, AND OTHER PROPERTY THAT MAY BE

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1	DONATED, DEVISED, OR CONVEYED THERETO AND TO UTILIZE THE SAME IN
2	SUCH MANNER AS SHALL BEST SERVE THE OBJECTS AND INTERESTS OF
3	CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS.
4	23-31.3-103. Academic policy. The president of CSU global
5	CAMPUS, REFERRED TO IN THIS ARTICLE AS THE "PRESIDENT", IN
6	CONSULTATION WITH THE GOVERNING COUNCIL AND THE FACULTY, HAS
7	THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR MAKING ACADEMIC POLICY AND GOVERNING THE
8	ACADEMIC AFFAIRS OF THE INSTITUTION.
9	23-31.3-104. President - duties. The president is chief
10	EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS, AND IT IS THE DUTY OF THE
11	PRESIDENT TO SEE THAT THE RULES OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
12	COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM ARE OBSERVED AND EXECUTED.
13	23-31.3-105. Board of governors - personnel power. The
14	BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM HAS
15	AUTHORITY OVER ALL PERSONNEL MATTERS RELATING TO THE SYSTEM,
16	INCLUDING CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS. IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION
17	23-5-117, THE BOARD MAY DELEGATE ALL OR PART OF ITS POWER OVER
18	PERSONNEL MATTERS. IF SUCH PERSONNEL POWERS ARE DELEGATED TO
19	THE PRESIDENT, THEN ALL EMPLOYEES OF CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS ARE
20	UNDER THE DIRECTION AND CONTROL OF THE PRESIDENT AND SHALL BE
21	REMOVABLE AT THE PRESIDENT'S DISCRETION. THE PRESIDENT MAY FILL
22	VACANCIES OF ALL EMPLOYEE POSITIONS AS DEEMED NECESSARY, SUBJECT
23	TO HIS OR HER PERSONNEL POWER.
24	23-31.3-106. President may be an instructor. The President
25	MAY PERFORM THE DUTIES OF AN INSTRUCTOR, AS THE BOARD OF
26	GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM SHALL
27	DETERMINE.

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1	23-31.3-107. Power to acquire land. The BOARD OF GOVERNORS
2	OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM HAS THE POWER TO TAKE
3	AND HOLD, BY GIFT, DEVISE, OR PURCHASE, SO MUCH LAND AS MAY
4	BECOME NECESSARY FOR THE LOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF
5	BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES, AND OTHER FACILITIES AS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR
6	THE USES AND PURPOSES OF COLORADO.
7	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-30-101, amend
8	(1) (a), (1) (b), (1) (g), and (1) (h) as follows:
9	23-30-101. Board of governors of the Colorado state university
10	system. (1) (a) A board is hereby established that shall be known by the
11	name and title of the board of governors of the Colorado state university
12	system, referred to in this section as the "board". It shall consist of a total
13	of thirteen FIFTEEN members as provided in paragraphs (b) and (c) of this
14	subsection (1).
15	(b) Four SIX of the members shall be advisory, without the right
16	to vote. The four SIX advisory members shall be elected OR APPOINTED by
17	their respective governing bodies from their membership. The advisory
18	officers shall serve terms of one academic year. The advisory members
19	shall consist of:
20	(I) One elected officer of the student body who is a full-time
21	junior or senior student at Colorado state university;
22	(II) One elected officer of the faculty council of Colorado state
23	university having the rank of associate professor or higher;
24	(III) One elected officer of the student body who is a full-time
25	junior or senior student at the Colorado state university - Pueblo; and
26	(IV) One elected officer of the faculty council of the Colorado
27	state university - Pueblo having the rank of associate professor or higher;

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1	(V) ONE STUDENT IN GOOD STANDING FROM THE CSU GLOBAL
2	CAMPUS STUDENT BODY, TO BE RECOMMENDED BY THE STUDENT AFFAIRS
3	COMMITTEE AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING COUNCIL AT CSU GLOBAL
4	CAMPUS; AND
5	(VI) ONE CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS FACULTY MEMBER WITH A
6	MINIMUM OF THREE YEARS OF SERVICE ON THE CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS
7	FACULTY, TO BE RECOMMENDED BY THE FACULTY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE
8	AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING COUNCIL AT CSU GLOBAL CAMPUS.
9	(g) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the term
10	of each member serving on the board of governors as of May 26, 2006,
11	shall be extended to expire on December 31 of the calendar year in which
12	the member's appointed term would otherwise expire. Members appointed
13	on or after January 1, 2007, shall serve terms of up to four years, expiring
14	on December 31 of the third calendar year following the calendar year in
15	which the member is appointed. For terms ending on or after December
16	31, 2006, the governor shall appoint a succeeding member on or before
17	March 1 immediately following the expiration of the term.
18	(h) No A person, elected or appointed under this section, shall
19	NOT serve on the board for more than two terms; regardless of the length
20	of the terms; except that a member of the board, whether elected or
21	appointed, shall continue to serve until a successor is elected or appointed
22	and confirmed by the senate.
23	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-30-102, amend
24	(1) as follows:
25	23-30-102. Board body corporate - powers relating to real and
26	personal property. (1) The board of governors of the Colorado state
27	university system is a body corporate, capable in law of suing and being

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1	sued; of taking, holding, acquiring, exchanging, selling, and determining
2	the uses of personal property and real estate, or any interest therein, the
3	ownership of which is vested in the board of governors of the Colorado
4	state university system or the entities governed by it; of contracting and
5	being contracted with; of having and using a corporate seal; HAVING
6	DUTIES AND POWERS TO CONTROL, MANAGE, AND DIRECT THE FISCAL AND
7	ALL OTHER AFFAIRS OF THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM AND
8	THE ENTITIES IT GOVERNS; and of causing to be done all things necessary
9	to carry out the provisions of this article.
10	<b>SECTION 4.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>amend</b> 23-30-104 as
11	follows:
12	23-30-104. Meetings of board. The board shall meet at the
13	Colorado state university twice annually and may meet at other times and
14	places at the call of the chair who has the power in case of emergency to
15	call special meetings of the board. THE CHAIR, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE
16	BOARD, SHALL ANNUALLY SET THE SCHEDULE FOR REGULAR BOARD
17	MEETINGS. Upon the written request of any three members of the board,
18	it is the duty of the chair of the board to call a special meeting thereof at
19	such time and place as shall be designated in the written request therefor.
20	A quorum of the board shall be IS a majority of voting members of the
21	board.
22	<b>SECTION 5.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-30-105, amend
23	(1) as follows:
24	23-30-105. Election of officers - terms. (1) The board of
25	governors of the Colorado state university system shall at a meeting to be
26	held in May elect from its membership a chair and a vice-chair and also
27	from its membership or from outside its membership a secretary and a

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treasurer, all of which said officers shall hold the office to which they are chosen for a period of two years from the date of election and until their successors are duly elected and qualified. The secretary shall give bond in an amount deemed sufficient by the board and discharge all the duties of said office account for all moneys which lawfully come into the secretary's hands, and pay the same over to the treasurer of the board on or before the tenth day of each month IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 23-30-107. The treasurer shall give bond in an amount deemed sufficient by the board and safely keep and account for all moneys received by the treasurer and pay the same out only on warrants of the board of governors of the Colorado state university system, signed by its chair and countersigned by its chief financial officer IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 23-30-108. The BOARD OF GOVERNORS MAY WAIVE THE BOND REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THIS SUBSECTION (1) AND IN LIEU THEREOF UTILIZE ALL APPLICABLE GOVERNMENTAL INSURANCE COVERAGE.

**SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 23-30-106, **amend** (1) and (2) as follows:

**23-30-106. Board of governors of the Colorado state university system fund - creation - control - use.** (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury the board of governors of the Colorado state university system fund which shall be Is under the control of and administered by the board of governors of the Colorado state university system in accordance with the provisions of this article. The board of governors shall have HAS authority and responsibility for all moneys of the board of governors and any entity governed by it. The board of governors shall designate, pursuant to its CONSTITUTIONAL AND statutory authority, those moneys received or acquired by the board of governors of the Colorado

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state university system or any of the entities it governs, whether by appropriation, grant, contract, or gift, by sale or lease of surplus real or personal property, or by any other means, whose disposition is not otherwise provided for by law, that shall be credited to the fund. All interest derived from the deposit and investment of moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund. The moneys in the fund are hereby continuously appropriated to the board of governors of the Colorado state university system and shall remain in the fund under the control of the board of governors and shall not be transferred or revert to the general fund of the state at the end of any fiscal year.

(2) The moneys in the board of governors of the Colorado state university system fund shall be used by the board of governors of the Colorado state university system for the payment of salaries and operating expenses of the board and the entities it governs and for the payment of any other expenses incurred by the board AND THE ENTITIES IT GOVERNS in carrying out its statutory powers and duties.

**SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 23-30-107 as follows:

23-30-107. Duties of secretary. The secretary of the board shall keep the secretary's office at such place as the board directs. It is the duty of the secretary to keep a record of the transactions of the board of governors of the Colorado state university system and keep and file all reports that may be required at any time, which shall be open at all times to the inspection of any citizen of the state. The secretary shall also have the custody of all books, papers, documents, and other property which may be deposited in the secretary's office.

**SECTION 8.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 23-30-108 as

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follows:

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2	23-30-108. Duties of treasurer - financial instruments signed
3	by whom - accounts. (1) All expenses of the board of governors of the
4	Colorado state university system shall be paid from the amounts duly set
5	aside by the board for said purpose by warrants duly signed by its chair
6	and countersigned by its chief financial officer as appointed by the board.
7	THE TREASURER OF THE BOARD SHALL KEEP A TRUE AND FAITHFUL
8	ACCOUNT OF ALL FUNDS SO RECEIVED IN SEPARATE ACCOUNTS ACCORDING
9	TO THE SOURCE OF THE FUNDS. THE TREASURER SHALL REPORT ON THE
10	FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE COLORADO STATE
11	UNIVERSITY SYSTEM, INCLUDING AN ANNUAL REPORT AT THE CLOSE OF
12	THE FISCAL YEAR AND OTHER REPORTS AS THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE. THE
13	DUTIES OF THE TREASURER MAY, UPON APPROVAL BY THE BOARD, BE
14	DELEGATED TO THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE COLORADO STATE
15	UNIVERSITY SYSTEM.
16	(2) WARRANTS, CHECKS, OR OTHER FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS
17	SHALL BE USED TO PAY THE EXPENSES OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF
18	THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM AND THE ENTITIES IT
19	GOVERNS, AND SHALL BE DULY SIGNED BY THE CHAIR AND
20	COUNTERSIGNED BY THE TREASURER OR THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER
21	APPOINTED BY THE BOARD FOR THE COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY
22	SYSTEM, OR THE PRESIDENTS OR THEIR DELEGATES.
23	<b>SECTION 9.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>amend</b> 23-30-109
24	as follows:
25	23-30-109. Program to be made. The board of governors of the
26	Colorado state university system and faculty shall, annually WHEN
27	DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE BOARD, make programs of theoretical and

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1	practical instruction.
2	<b>SECTION 10.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>amend</b> 23-30-118
3	as follows:
4	23-30-118. Board to fix salaries. The board shall fix the salaries
5	of the chancellor, presidents, AND OTHER SYSTEM STAFF THAT REPORT
6	DIRECTLY TO THE BOARD AND SHALL PRESCRIBE THEIR RESPECTIVE
7	DUTIES. THE BOARD MAY DELEGATE THE AUTHORITY TO SET SALARIES FOR
8	professors and other employees of the system and universities and
9	prescribe their respective duties to the Chancellor and Presidents.
10	The board may remove the chancellor, presidents, or subordinate officers
11	and fill all vacancies.
12	SECTION 11. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 23-30-119
13	as follows:
14	23-30-119. Board to confer degrees. The board, with the advice
15	of the faculty INSTITUTIONS IT GOVERNS, shall confer such degrees or
16	testimonials as are conferred by similar institutions.
17	<b>SECTION 12.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>amend</b> 23-30-120
18	as follows:
19	23-30-120. Payment of expenses. (1) The current The BOARD OF
20	GOVERNORS SHALL HAVE GENERAL SUPERVISION, CONTROL, AND
21	DIRECTION OF THE FUNDS AND APPROPRIATIONS MADE THERETO. ALL
22	expenses of the board of governors of the Colorado state university
23	system the Colorado state university, and the Colorado state university -
24	Pueblo AND THE ENTITIES IT GOVERNS shall be paid from the amounts
25	duly set aside by the board for said purpose, by warrants drawn on the
26	treasurer of the board, duly signed by its chair and countersigned by its
27	secretary FUNDS RECEIVED OR MAINTAINED BY THE BOARD OR THE

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1	ENTITIES IT GOVERNS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROCEDURES LISTED IN
2	SECTION 23-30-108.
3	(2) It is the duty of the controller when any funds are available for
4	the use and benefit of the board or the entities it governs, upon an order
5	signed by the chair and countersigned by the secretary of the board of
6	governors of the Colorado state university system in favor of the treasurer
7	of the board, to issue a warrant upon the state treasurer in favor of the
8	treasurer of the board.
9	(3) The treasurer of the board shall keep a just and true account
10	of all funds so received in separate accounts according to the source of
11	the funds and make a report thereon, from time to time, to the board of
12	governors of the Colorado state university system, including an annual
13	report at the close of the fiscal year and such separate and other reports
14	as the board may require, concerning all of the funds. The duties of the
15	treasurer may, upon approval by the board, be delegated to the chief
16	financial officer of the Colorado state university system.
17	<b>SECTION 13.</b> In Colorado Revised Statutes, <b>repeal</b> 23-30-124.
18	SECTION 14. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-51-1101, amend
19	(1.8) (e) (II) (B) as follows:
20	24-51-1101. Employment after service retirement.
21	(1.8) (e) (II) As used in this paragraph (e), "principal campus" means:
22	(B) Each institution of the Colorado state university system
23	established in sections 23-31-101 and 23-31.5-101, C.R.S., but not
24	including the on-line university established in section 23-30-124,
25	23-31.3-101, C.R.S.; and
26	SECTION 15. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
27	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the

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ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 1 2 8, 2012, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a 3 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 4 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 5 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 6 7 November 2012 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 8 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
