A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING COMMERCIAL VEHICLE STANDARDS APPLIED TO CERTAIN

102 VEHICLES UNDER TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE POUNDS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill raises from 10,001 to 26,001 pounds the gross combination rating of a motor vehicle and trailer that triggers compliance with the commercial vehicle standards. In addition, a person who is transporting livestock in a motor vehicle and trailer combination is exempt from the standards if the motor vehicle without the trailer is not a commercial vehicle exceeding 14,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating, regardless of whether the trailer would make it exceed that weight.

6	(IV) This section does not apply to a motor vehicle or
7	MOTOR VEHICLE AND TRAILER COMBINATION:
8	(A) WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT, GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT
9	RATING, OR GROSS COMBINATION RATING OF LESS THAN TWENTY-SIX
10	THOUSAND ONE POUNDS;
11	(B) NOT OPERATED IN INTERSTATE COMMERCE;
12	(C) NOT TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS REQUIRING
13	PLACARDING;
14	(D) NOT TRANSPORTING EITHER SIXTEEN OR MORE PASSENGERS
15	INCLUDING THE DRIVER OR EIGHT OR MORE PASSENGERS FOR
16	COMPENSATION; AND
17	(E) THE MOTOR VEHICLE OR COMBINATION IS BEING USED SOLELY
18	FOR AGRICULTURAL PURPOSES.
19	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -
20	applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
21	the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the

23	2012); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
