The Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee Report makes a change to the definition of commercial mobile radio service to exclude paging services and adds cooperative electric associations to the list of entities eligible to bid into a request for proposal (RFP) put forth by the Governor's Office of Information Technology for the broadband fund grants.

Legislative Council staff and Joint Budget Committee staff concur that the Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee Report does <u>not</u> impact the estimated cost of implementing the bill.
