**TITLE:** CONCERNING PARENT INVOLVEMENT IN EDUCATION.**Summary of Legislation**

This bill modifies the composition of the Colorado State Advisory Council for Parent Involvement in Education (CSACPIE), and specifies definitions affecting the composition of school and district accountability committees. The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.

**Background**

Senate Bill 09-090 created the CSACPIE in the Colorado Department of Education. The council's composition includes parents of public school children, and representatives from federally funded parent centers, teachers, administrators, school boards, state agencies, and education associations. The council advises state agencies concerning best practices and strategies for increasing parent involvement in education and promoting family and school partnerships.
