## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill requires hospitals to provide notice of all services that the hospital refuses to provide because of religious beliefs or moral convictions. The notice must inform patients of their right to obtain these services from another hospital. The hospital must provide the notice prior to or at admission of the patient or as soon after admission as is practicable. The Department of Public Health and Environment will specify the manner of notice that must be provided.

## **State Expenditures**

The Department of Public Health and Environment will develop a rule to address the bill requirements. The workload associated with the rulemaking is expected to be minimal and to be addressed within existing appropriations.
