## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill increases the penalty for parking in front of a fire hydrant in unincorporated areas of a county. Under current law, the penalty for this infraction is between \$15 and \$100. This bill increases the penalty to a range of \$150 to \$200.

#### **State Revenue**

This bill may increase state revenue from fines collected from infractions. Revenue is expected to be less than \$5,000 per year.

# **Local Government Impact**

This bill may increase county revenue from fines collected from infractions. County revenue is expected to be less than \$5,000 per year.
