<u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 03/09/12 Legislative Council Staff</u> Revised Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the Finance Committee 03/15/12)

The Finance Committee Report dated 03/15/12 strikes the following provisions from the Education Committee Report dated 02/27/12:

- A provision allowing the Department to promulgate rules concerning parental notification when a school employee is charged with or arrested for a criminal offense; and
- A provision giving the Commissioner of Education the authority to issue subpoenas compelling the production of evidence related to investigations of allegations affecting educator licensing determinations.

Joint Budget Committee Staff and Legislative Council Staff agree that the Finance Committee Report does <u>not</u> change the fiscal impact of the bill as described in the revised fiscal note.
