TITLE: CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON COVERING ALL

CHILDREN IN COLORADO.

Summary of Legislation

This bill repeals the Advisory Committee on Covering All Children in Colorado. The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.

Background

The 15-member Advisory Committee on Covering All Children in Colorado was established in 2007 for the purpose of overseeing a plan to provide health coverage for all low-income children in Colorado by 2010. Under current law, members serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for expenses if gifts, grants, or donations are received.

Assessment

This bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The committee is comprised of volunteers, who served without compensation and did not receive any gifts, grants, or donations. The bill does not alter workload and there is no ongoing funding for the program in the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing's base budget request for FY 2012-13.
