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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

101 **CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT THE LIMITED GAMING CONTROL**  
102 **COMMISSION TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE IMPACT ON ALL**  
103 **AUTHORIZED RECIPIENTS OF GAMING TAX REVENUE WHEN**  
104 **CONSIDERING CHANGES IN RULES GOVERNING THE TAXES ON**  
105 **LIMITED GAMING ACTIVITY.**

control commission to receive testimony from all authorized recipients of distributions of revenue generated through limited gaming activity under constitutional and statutory provisions.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47.1-601, **add**  
3 (1.5) as follows:

4           **12-47.1-601. Gaming tax.** (1.5) WHEN ADOPTING OR AMENDING  
5 ANY RULE AFFECTING THE APPLICABLE TAX RATE OR ANY OTHER  
6 ATTRIBUTE OR POLICY RELATING TO APPLICATION OF THE GAMING TAX  
7 AUTHORIZED BY SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION SHALL  
8 CONSIDER THE IMPACT ON RECIPIENTS OF EXTENDED LIMITED GAMING TAX  
9 PROCEEDS.

10           **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
11 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
12 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
13 8, 2012, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a  
14 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
15 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
16 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
17 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
18 November 2012 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
19 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
