A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

The bill makes appropriations for matters related to the legislative department for the 2012-13 fiscal year. The bill makes an appropriation to the youth advisory council cash fund. The state treasurer and controller must transfer to the legislative department cash fund any general fund appropriations to the legislative department for a fiscal year commencing

on or after July 1, 2011, that are unexpended and unencumbered as of the close of that fiscal year.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Appropriation. In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, to the legislative department of the state of Colorado, the sum of \$34,326,736, or so much thereof as may be necessary, of which amount \$33,237,355 shall be out of any moneys in the general fund not otherwise appropriated, \$179,065 shall be from cash funds, and \$910,316 shall be from reappropriated funds, for payment of the expenses of the legislative department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012, to be allocated as follows:

11	In addition, it is anticipated that, during the 2012-13 fiscal year,		
12	the tax levy on civil actions provided for in section 2-5-119,		
13	Colorado Revised Statutes, will return approximately \$326,000 to		
14	the general fund to offset expenses of the revision of statutes by		
15	the office of legislative legal services.		
16	SECTION 2. Appropriation. In addition to any other		
17	appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the		
18	general fund not otherwise appropriated, to the youth advisory council		
19	cash fund created in section 2-2-1306, Colorado Revised Statutes, for the		
20	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012, the sum of \$8,472, to be used for		
21	purposes consistent with the creation of the fund.		
22	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1601, add (2.6)		
23	as follows:		
24	2-2-1601. Legislative department cash fund - redistricting		
25	account - creation. (2.6) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW TO THE		
26	CONTRARY, ANY MONEYS APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO		
27	THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT FOR ANY		

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- FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2011, THAT ARE
 UNEXPENDED OR NOT ENCUMBERED AS OF THE CLOSE OF THAT FISCAL
 YEAR SHALL NOT REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND AND SHALL BE
 TRANSFERRED BY THE STATE TREASURER AND THE CONTROLLER TO THE
 LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT CASH FUND.
- SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
