Summary of the Bill

The bill is the annual legislative appropriation bill. It contains the majority of appropriations related to the operations of the House of Representatives, the Senate, and the legislative staff agencies for FY 2012-13.

JBC Staff Concurrence with Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note

Pursuant to Joint Rule 22(b), the Legislative Council Staff does not review bills limited to appropriations measures carrying specific dollar amounts for fiscal impacts. Section 1 of the bill appropriates a total of \$34,369,754 for the Legislative Department for FY 2012-13. Section 2 of the bill provides an appropriation of \$8,472 General Fund to the Youth Advisory Council Cash Fund for FY 2012-13 to be used for purposes consistent with the creation of the fund. Section 3 of the bill indicates any moneys from the legislative appropriation, as of the close of the fiscal year, that are unexpended or not encumbered shall not revert to the General Fund and shall be transferred to the Legislative Department Cash Fund.
