<u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 01/20/12 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal</u> <u>Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Economic and Business Development Committee</u> 02/02/12)

The House Economic and Business Development Committee Report amended the bill to *request* rather than *require* health care professionals to provide data and changed *date* of birth to *year* of birth in the list of requested data.

The above amendments do not affect the fiscal impact of the bill, as delineated in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated January 20, 2012.
