These amendments do not affect the fiscal impact of the bill. **JBC Staff Concurrence with Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note** XXX | Concurs **Does Not Concur Updated Analysis Amendments/Appropriation Status** The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause. Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$75,500 cash funds (from fees paid by private colleges and universities) to the Department of Higher Education. The appropriation clause assumes the repurposing of \$20,500 of unused cash funds spending authority associated with S.B. 08-167. **Bill Sponsor Amendments** Staff is not aware of any sponsor amendments to be offered. **Points to Consider** None.
