<u>Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 02/20/12 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note Was Prepared (Amended by the House Local Government Committee 02/22/12)</u>

The House Local Government Committee Report added a provision that requires all rules adopted be consistent with federal laws and regulations including rules promulgated by the United States Food and Drug Administration. It also added technical amendments to include audiologists where hearing aid providers are specified, that the introduced bill had omitted.

The above amendments do not affect the fiscal impact of the bill, as delineated in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated February 20, 2012. Legislative Council staff agrees with this assessment.
