12	SCOPE OF PRACTICE.
13	(b) As used in this subsection (3) "auricular acudetox"
14	MEANS THE SUBCUTANEOUS INSERTION OF STERILE, DISPOSABLE
15	ACUPUNCTURE NEEDLES IN THE FOLLOWING FIVE CONSISTENT,
16	PREDETERMINED BILATERAL LOCATIONS:
17	(I) Sympathetic;
18	(II) SHEN MEN;
19	(III) KIDNEY;
20	(IV) LIVER; AND
21	(V) Lung.
22	SECTION 2. Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2012.
23	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.".
