A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE TRANSFER OF MONEYS FROM THE STATE RAIL BANK 102 FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee Budget Package Bill. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer to the general fund any unexpended and unencumbered moneys remaining in the state rail bank fund as of June 30, 2012. Currently, there is \$9,356,000 in the state rail bank fund, and the transfer will be for this amount plus any interest that may accrue.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 43-1-1309, add (4)
3	as follows:

5	(4) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS
6	SECTION TO THE CONTRARY, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER TO
7	THE GENERAL FUND ANY UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEYS
8	REMAINING IN THE STATE RAIL BANK FUND AS OF JUNE 30, 2012.
9	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
