The bill confers peace officer status on a city attorney, town attorney, senior assistant city attorney, assistant city attorney, chief deputy city attorney, deputy city attorney, special deputy city attorney, prosecuting attorney, senior prosecutor, or special prosecutor employed or contracted by a municipality, city, town,

SUCH PEACE OFFICER'S AUTHORITY SHALL 16 INCLUDE THE ENFORCEMENT OF ALL LAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY, CITY, 17 TOWN, STATUTORY CITY OR TOWN, OR CITY AND COUNTY AND THE STATE 18 OF COLORADO, AND THE PEACE OFFICER MAY BE CERTIFIED BY THE 19 P.O.S.T. BOARD. 20 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (1) OF 21 THIS SECTION, THE PEACE OFFICER STATUS CONFERRED BY SUBSECTION (1) 22 OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE AVAILABLE TO AN ATTORNEY SPECIFIED IN 23 SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION WHO CHOOSES TO PRACTICE AS A 24 CRIMINAL DEFENSE ATTORNEY IN THE STATE OF COLORADO WHILE ALSO 25 WORKING AS A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OR AN ATTORNEY WHO
