Bill Summary

Under current law, the associate county judge for Montrose county must have his or her official residence in the portion of Montrose county that is in the southwestern water conservation district. The bill repeals this requirement and requires the associate county judge to have his or her residence within Montrose county and court chambers in the city of

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 13-6-209, **amend** (1)
3 as follows:

4 **13-6-209. Special associate and associate county judges -**
5 **designated counties.** (1) In the county of Montrose there shall be an
6 associate county judge who shall maintain his OR HER official residence
7 **IN MONTROSE COUNTY AND COURT CHAMBERS in that portion of Montrose**
8 **county which THAT is included in the southwestern water conservation**
9 **district as set forth and described in section 37-47-103, C.R.S.**

10 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
