## **Bill Summary**

The bill extends the period for which state income tax return forms

shall include a line whereby individual taxpayers may make a voluntary contribution to the nongame and endangered wildlife fund.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 39-22-702 as 3 follows: 4 39-22-702. Voluntary contribution designation - procedure. 5 For income tax years commencing on or after January 1, 2009 JANUARY 6 1, 2012, but prior to January 1, 2012 JANUARY 1, 2017, each Colorado 7 state individual income tax return form shall contain a line whereby each 8 individual taxpayer may designate the amount of the contribution, if any, 9 such individual wishes to make to the nongame and endangered wildlife 10 cash fund created in section 39-22-703. 11 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 39-22-704 as follows: 12 13 **39-22-704.** Repeal of part. This part 7 is repealed, effective 14 January 1, 2013 JANUARY 1, 2018, unless the voluntary contribution to the 15 nongame and endangered wildlife cash fund established in section 16 39-22-703 is continued or reestablished by the general assembly acting by 17 bill prior to said date. 18 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 19 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 20 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 21 7, 2012, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a 22 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 23 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 24 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 25 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
