# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF AN ON-LINE EDUCATION PROGRAM AS A MULTI-DISTRICT PROGRAM IF THE PROGRAM IS AUTHORIZED BY A BOARD OF COOPERATIVE SERVICES.

#### **Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** Under current law, a board of cooperative services (BOCES) may authorize either a single-district or a multi-district on-line educational program. The bill permits a BOCES to authorize only a multi-district program.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-30.7-102, amend
3	(13) as follows:
4	22-30.7-102. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the
5	context otherwise requires:
6	(13) "Single-district program" means an on-line program that
7	serves only students who reside within a single school district. or, in the
8	case of a program authorized by one or more districts, or a board of
9	cooperative services, an on-line program that serves only students who
10	reside within the authorizing districts. or within the member districts of
11	the authorizing board of cooperative services.
12	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-30.7-105, amend
13	(1) (a) as follows:
14	22-30.7-105. Program criteria - guidelines - quality standards
15	- records - rules. (1) (a) A school district a group of two or more school
16	districts, a board of cooperative services created pursuant to section
17	22-5-104, and the state charter school institute established pursuant to
18	section 22-30.5-503 are hereby authorized to create or oversee
19	single-district programs.
20	<b>SECTION 3.</b> Effective date. This act takes effect July 1, 2012.
21	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
22	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
23	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
