A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING SERVICES PROVIDED BY A PERSON DESIGNATED BY A**
102 **PERSON ELIGIBLE FOR CONSUMER-DIRECTED CARE SERVICES.**

Bill Summary

A person eligible for consumer-directed care services (eligible person) may designate a family member or authorized representative to be responsible for managing financial matters associated with the eligible person's care or to direct the eligible person's care. The bill authorizes the designee to be a direct service provider for the eligible person.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

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4 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 15-14-310, **amend**
5 (5) (a) as follows:

6 **15-14-310. Who may be guardian - priorities - prohibition of**
7 **dual roles.** (5) (a) Unless the court makes specific findings for good
8 cause shown or the person is a family caregiver as defined in section
9 27-10.5-102 (15.5), C.R.S., OR THE PERSON IS A CAREGIVER TO AN
10 ELIGIBLE PERSON PURSUANT TO SECTION 25.5-6-1101 (4), C.R.S., the
11 same professional may not act as an incapacitated person's or a protected
12 person's:

- 12 (I) Guardian and conservator; or
13 (II) Guardian and direct service provider; or
14 (III) Conservator and direct service provider.

16 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
