**Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that makes the following appropriations to the Department of Public Health and Environment from the Vital Statistics Records Cash Fund:

- In FY 2012-13, \$6,976 cash funds and 0.1 FTE for the development of forms, procedures, vital records computer system changes, printing and personnel costs to review records submitted by county clerks; and
- In FY 2013-14, \$4,021 cash funds and 0.1 FTE for the review of records submitted by county clerks.
