A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION TO RENEW A STATE-ISSUED
102 IDENTIFICATION CARD BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.

Bill Summary

The bill authorizes a person over 65 years of age to electronically renew an identification card issued by the department of revenue.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-304, **add** (1.8)
2 as follows:

3 **42-2-304. Validity of identification card - rules.** (1.8) (a) THE
4 DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT TO RENEW AN IDENTIFICATION
5 CARD ISSUED UNDER SECTION 42-2-302 BY ELECTRONIC MEANS IF THE
6 APPLICANT:

- 7 (I) IS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER;
- 8 (II) ATTESTS UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY TO BEING LAWFULLY
9 PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES;
- 10 (III) ATTESTS UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY TO BEING A RESIDENT
11 OF COLORADO; AND
- 12 (IV) PAYS ANY REQUIRED FEE OR SURCHARGE.

13 (b) APPLICANTS WHO MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF PARAGRAPH
14 (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1) MAY ELECTRONICALLY RENEW EVERY
15 RENEWAL PERIOD.

16 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
17 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
18 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
19 general assembly (August 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8,
20 2013); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
21 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
22 or part of this act within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of
23 the general assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
24 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
25 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
26 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

27 (2) This act applies to identification card renewals on or after

1 January 1, 2014.
