Summary of Legislation

Recommended by the *Transportation Legislation Review Committee*, this bill requires the Department of Personnel and Administration (DPA) to report on the number of alternative fuel vehicles purchased, the availability of alternative fuel, and a plan for putting in place the infrastructure necessary to support the use of alternative fuel vehicles in the state's fleet, among other related criteria. The report is to be provided to the transportation committees and the Joint Budget Committee of the General Assembly on or before November 1, 2013, and each November 1 thereafter.

State Expenditures

This bill will increase workload within DPA by a minimal amount to prepare the required report. No increase in appropriations is required for DPA.
