Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$49,488 General Fund and 0.9 FTE for FY 2013-14, including \$45,742 and 0.8 FTE to the Judicial Department for trial courts, and \$3,746 and 0.1 FTE to the Department of Public Safety for the State Point of Contact-national Instant Criminal Background Check Program.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The general appropriations bill for FY 2013-14 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$49,488 for FY 2013-14, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs.
