TITLE: CONCERNING REQUIREMENTS AFFECTING THE DESIGNATION BY PETITION OF CANDIDATES IN CONNECTION WITH THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARDS OF COMMISSIONERS OF COUNTIES FOLLOWING A CHANGE IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SAID BOARDS.

Summary of Legislation

In any county where voters have increased the membership of the board of county commissioners from 3 to 5 or have decreased membership of the board from 5 to 3, this bill specifies the signature requirements for candidates for a county commissioner seat during the 4 years following the membership change. The bill specifies signature requirements both for major political party candidates, and for candidates who choose not to affiliate with a major political party. The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 24, 2013.

Assessment

This bill does not change the expenditures or revenue of the Secretary of State or of local government clerk and recorders when conducting elections, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
