The Senate Transportation Committee Report (04/23/13) delays the effective date from July 1, 2014 to July 1, 2016 for the provisions in the bill that extend the exemption from vehicle emission inspections for new vehicles from four to seven years. The Report thus eliminates the fiscal impact of the bill for FY 2013-14. Legislative Council Staff agrees with this assessment.
