CONCERNING APPROVAL OF THE PERFORMANCE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COLORADO SCHOOL OF MINES AND THE COLORADO COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, The General Assembly has recognized Colorado School of Mines as an exemplary institution of higher education that has demonstrated a high degree of responsibility and capability with regard to its academic and administrative functions; and

WHEREAS, The General Assembly authorized Colorado School of Mines to be the first Colorado institution of higher education to operate under a performance contract; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to sections 23-1-108 (1.5) (f) and 23-41-104.6, Colorado Revised Statutes, the Colorado Commission on Higher Education and Colorado School of Mines have negotiated a new performance contract; and

WHEREAS, Section 23-41-104.6 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, provides that the performance contract shall not take effect until approved by a joint resolution adopted by the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, Section 23-41-104.6 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, also requires approval of the terms of the performance contract by a majority of the members of the education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate and the members of the Joint Budget Committee of the General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, Said education committees and said Joint Budget Committee met in a joint session on January 30, 2013, to review the provisions of the contract, and a majority of the members of said committees approved the terms of the performance contract; and

WHEREAS, Section 23-41-104.6 (4), Colorado Revised Statutes, requires the chairpersons of the education committees of the House of Representatives and the Senate, in cooperation with the Joint Budget Committee, to sponsor a joint resolution to recognize and approve the performance contract, and the performance contract is deemed approved upon the final passage of said joint resolution; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Sixty-ninth General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:

That the new performance contract between the Colorado School of Mines and the Colorado Commission on Higher Education is hereby recognized and approved.

Be It Further Resolved, That copies of this Joint Resolution be sent to the board of trustees of the Colorado School of Mines and to the Colorado Commission on Higher Education.
