A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF BUSINESS INFORMATION BY THE**
102 **SECRETARY OF STATE.**

Bill Summary

The bill requires the secretary of state to request information from each business owner that files documents with the secretary of state regarding whether the business is owned by a woman, minority, veteran, or person with a disability and requires the secretary of state to make the information available to the public.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 24-21-114 as
3 follows:

4 **24-21-114. Secretary of state collection of business information.**

5 BEGINNING THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE OF THIS SECTION, THE
6 SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL REQUEST THAT EACH INDIVIDUAL WHO FILES
7 DOCUMENTS WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE PURSUANT TO PART 3 OF
8 ARTICLE 90 OF TITLE 7, C.R.S., SUBMIT INFORMATION TO THE SECRETARY
9 OF STATE STATING WHETHER THE REPORTING ENTITY, AS THAT TERM IS
10 DEFINED IN SECTION 7-90-102 (58), C.R.S., TO WHICH THE FILING RELATES
11 IS OWNED BY A WOMAN, MINORITY, VETERAN, OR PERSON WITH A
12 DISABILITY. THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT REQUIRED TO SUBMIT THE
13 INFORMATION. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAKE THE INFORMATION
14 AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.

15 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
16 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
