## **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$187,816 cash funds to the Department of Revenue for FY 2013-14 as follows:

- \$68,212 from the Colorado State Titling and Registration Account in the Highway Users Tax Fund (HUTF) to the Information Technology Division for the purchase of computer center services. These moneys are reappropriated to the Governor's Office of Information Technology.
- \$110,400 from the HUTF (for administration of the collection of fuel taxes) to the Taxpayer Service Division for the purchase of contract services to program the fuel tracking system and the GenTax system.
