Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause for FY 2013-14. This bill creates the Waste Tire Fee Administration Cash Fund and credits administrative fees paid to the Department of Revenue for the collection of waste tire fees. For purposes of this fiscal analysis, staff assumes that this bill will pass prior to the introduction of the FY 2013-14 Long Bill (currently March 25) and that the FY 2013-14 Long Bill will include the appropriations authorized by this bill. If this bill does not pass prior to the Long Bill introduction, the Long Bill will include the current appropriation and this bill will require an appropriation clause that adjusts the letternote in the Taxpayer Service Division.
