**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating 0.6 FTE and \$58,966 from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies, reappropriating \$11,294 to the Department of Law for the provision of legal services, and reappropriating \$10,993 to the Governor's Office of Information Technology for the provision of computer center services for FY 2013-14.
