### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$9,020 General Fund and 0.1 FTE to the Division of Criminal Justice in the Department of Public Safety for FY 2013-14.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### GF Expenditures

The Joint Budget Committee introduced a budget package for FY 2013-14 based on the March 2013 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package appropriates all but approximately \$8.0 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available, less a statutorily required five percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$9,020 for FY 2013-14.
