A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION TO RENEW A STATE-ISSUED**
102 **IDENTIFICATION CARD BY ELECTRONIC MEANS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill authorizes a person over 65 years of age to electronically renew an identification card issued by the department of revenue.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-304, **amend**
2 **(1.7) (a) (II); and add (1.8) as follows:**

3 **42-2-304. Validity of identification card - rules.** (1.7) (a) If
4 **allowed under federal law, the department shall allow renewal of an**
5 **identification card issued under section 42-2-302 by mail subject to the**
6 **following requirements:**

7 **(II) Renewal by mail shall IS only be available every other renewal**
8 **period; EXCEPT THAT RENEWAL BY MAIL IS AVAILABLE EVERY RENEWAL**
9 **PERIOD IF THE APPLICANT IS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.**

10 **(1.8) (a) THE** DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT TO
11 RENEW AN IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED UNDER SECTION 42-2-302 BY
12 ELECTRONIC MEANS IF THE APPLICANT:

- 13 (I) IS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER;
- 14 (II) ATTESTS UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY TO BEING LAWFULLY
15 PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES;
- 16 (III) ATTESTS UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY TO BEING A RESIDENT
17 OF COLORADO; AND
- 18 (IV) PAYS ANY REQUIRED FEE OR SURCHARGE.

19 (b) APPLICANTS WHO MEET THE QUALIFICATIONS OF PARAGRAPH
20 (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1) MAY ELECTRONICALLY RENEW EVERY
21 RENEWAL PERIOD.

22 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**
23 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
24 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
25 general assembly (August 7, 2013, if adjournment sine die is on May 8,
26 2013); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
27 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,

1 or part of this act within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of
2 the general assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
3 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
4 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
5 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

6 (2) This act applies to identification card renewals on or after
7 January 1, 2014.
