J.001 Staff has prepared amendment J.001 (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$4,588 cash funds from the Licensing Services Cash Fund in FY 2013-14 to the Department of Revenue, Information Technology Division, Systems Support for the purchase of programming services from the Governor's Office of Information Technology. The amendment reappropriates those moneys from the Department of Revenue to the Office of the Governor-Lieutenant Governor - State Planning and Budgeting, Office of Information Technology.
