	SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 13-023
101	CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION OF A REPLICA KHACHKAR AND
102	EXPLANATORY PLAQUE IN THE RENOVATED ARMENIAN GARDEN
103	ON THE CAPITOL GROUNDS.
1	WHEREAS, The State Capitol and its grounds contain memorials
2 3	to the state's political past as well as memorabilia promoting the state's
3 4	natural environment and history of events, individuals, and ethnic groups; and
5	WHEREAS, From time to time, proposals for gifts of art and
6	memorials are made to the state to be placed in the State Capitol or on its
7	grounds; and
Q	WHEREAS Senate Bill 92-213 directed the State Capital

Building Advisory Committee to establish criteria and a procedure for the 1 evaluation of proposals for gifts of memorials for placement in the State 2 3 Capitol or on its grounds; and 4 WHEREAS, The State Capitol Building Advisory Committee's evaluation criteria for a memorial is based partly upon the association the 5 proposed memorial has with a significant event in the state's history, the 6 7 connection of the memorial with persons significant in the heritage of the 8 state, and its appropriateness to the designated area of the State Capitol; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, The procedure stipulates that, if the Capital 11 Development Committee and the Governor concur with the State Capitol Building Advisory Committee's recommendations regarding the 12 placement of memorials on the State Capitol grounds, the Capital 13 14 Development Committee may make its recommendation for acceptance of the donated art to the General Assembly in the form of a joint 15 resolution introduced during an annual legislative session; and 16 17 WHEREAS, The State Capitol Building Advisory Committee, the 18 Capital Development Committee, and the Governor have approved a plan 19 for placement of a replica khachkar and an accompanying explanatory plaque in the renovated Armenian Garden on the State Capitol grounds; 20 21 and

WHEREAS, The proposed language for the explanatory plaque reads as follows: "This memorial honors the victims and descendants of the 1915 Armenian Genocide on the 100th anniversary of that great tragedy. The genocide prompted Coloradans to come to the aid of the remaining few who became known as "the starving Armenians." This Armenian cultural monument is a replica of a khachkar, crafted in 1583, from the medieval Armenian cemetery in Djulfa. The largest collection of these intricately carved khachkars, located in the Djulfa cemetery, was destroyed in 2005. The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization has since recognized the value and vulnerability of this art form by declaring it part of the intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity."; and

WHEREAS, The replica khachkar in the renovated Armenian Garden would serve to memorialize the victims of the 1915 Armenian genocide; now, therefore,
