#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$99,673 General Fund and 1.5 FTE to the Governor's Office of Information Technology and \$75,247 General Fund and 1.2 FTE for the Legislative Department for the implementation of the provisions of this bill.

#### **Points to Consider**

The Joint Budget Committee introduced a budget package for FY 2013-14 based on the March 2013 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package appropriates all but approximately \$8.0 million of General Fund revenues projected to be available, less a statutorily required five percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$174,920 for FY 2013-14.
