## Fiscal Impact of Bill as Amended to Date

The most recent Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note (attached) reflects the fiscal impact of the bill as of 02/18/13.

Section 5 of the bill requires the School Safety Resource Center (Center) to "contract for the services of a full-time grant writer". The Legislative Council Staff Revised Fiscal Note assumes that a full-time state employee will be hired to perform the additional duties under the bill. Because the bill reqires the Center to contract for the services of a grant writer, JBC staff does not believe that the intent of the bill is to hire a state employee.

The Department of Public Safety estimates that experienced grant writers charge between \$75-\$100 per hour for their services and that the bill requires 1,040 hours of contract services. At this price, the Department would need between \$78,000 and \$104,000 General Fund to meet the requirements of the bill.

## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$78,000 General Fund for FY 2013-14 to the Department of Public Safety's School Safety Resource Center.

#### L.003 and J.002

Bill Sponsor amendment **L.003** (attached) strikes language in the bill requiring the School Safety Resource Center to contract for the services of a full-time grant writer in order to perform the additional duties required by the bill. If amendment **L.003** is adopted, staff has prepared corresponding amendment **J.002** to add a provision appropriating \$57,815 General Fund and 1.0 FTE for the School Safety Resources Center to hire a full-time state employee to implement the requirements of the bill.

# The Committee should adopt J.001 or J.002, but not both.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The general appropriations bill for FY 2013-14 has not yet been introduced. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$78,000 for FY 2013-14, reducing the amount of General Fund available for other existing programs.
