Summary of Legislation

Recommended by the Joint Budget Committee, this bill makes three transfers to the Capital Construction Fund (CCF). For FY 2012-13, the bill transfers \$420,184 from the General Fund to the CCF for additional costs associated with one project. For FY 2013-14, the bill transfers \$193,066,495 for 102 state-funded capital construction and controlled maintenance projects listed in the 2013 Long Bill, including \$192,566,495 from the General Fund and \$500,000 from the General Fund Exempt account to the CCF.
