After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB13-194 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, after line 3 insert:

2 **"SECTION 4. Wind up - satisfying obligations of low-income**
3 **telephone assistance fund.** Notwithstanding the repeal of article 3.4 of
4 title 40, the low-income telephone assistance fund continues until July 1,
5 2013, to satisfy remaining financial obligations of the fund. In winding
6 up the Colorado telephone low-income assistance program, the public
7 utilities commission may use the moneys in the fund to make
8 disbursement to the carriers, pay administrative expenses of the
9 department of human services, and offset costs of ending the program. On
10 July 1, 2013, the treasurer shall transfer the remainder of the moneys in
11 the fund to the general fund."
